Dr. Thomas J. Goldsby is the James E. Dockter Associate Professor of Supply Chain Management at the University of Kentucky, and (effective July 2011) Professor of Logistics at The Ohio State University. He has held previous faculty appointments at The Ohio State University and Iowa State University. Dr. Goldsby holds a B.S. in Business Administration from the University of Evansville, MBA from the University of Kentucky, and Ph.D. from Michigan State University.

Dr. Goldsby's research interests are logistics customer service, supply chain integration, and the theory and practice of lean and agile supply chain strategies. He has published several articles in academic and professional journals and serves as a frequent speaker at academic conferences, executive education seminars, and professional meetings. He is co-author of *Lean Six Sigma Logistics: Strategic Development to Operational Success* (2005). Dr. Goldsby has served as a consultant to manufacturers, distributors, retailers, logistics service providers, non-governmental organizations, and the U.S. Department of Defense. He has received multiple awards for this research and teaching, and was recently recognized as one of the most productive researchers all-time in the field of Logistics Management.
